



General Storage Guidance Notes for Moulded Plastic Articles

Materials • LDPE • HDPE • PP • PETG • ABS • Nylon

As there are no specific international standards relating to the storage environments of finished plastic components or articles, the general notes below should be considered for best practice or guidance during medium to long term storage.

The storage of plastic articles:

- Store in a cool, dry environment wherever possible
- Keep humidity levels ideally below 50%
- Store away from direct sunlight (UV)
- Storage temperatures ideally should not exceed 40°C
- Store away from direct sources of heat

Please note: Prolonged excessive heat (temperatures exceeding 30-40°C) can cause some plastics to lose a degree of rigidity. Whilst, in most cases, this will be reversed once cooled, some deformation may occur if kept at these higher temperature ranges for prolonged periods.

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
